"In our most recent NDC," said Permanent Secretary Anita Montoute addressing the NCCC, "we committed to reducing greenhouse gas emissions from the energy and transport sectors by 7%, below 2010 ...

In February 2025, Saint Lucia became the first Caribbean country to submit its NDC 3.0, strengthening its commitments on both mitigation and adaptation. The NDC 3.0 doubles its previous ...
